


## **CROSSWORD: A Sampling of Nova Scotia's Designated Trades**

- 2. Builds sea-going boats; fast patrol boats; and pleasure boats, power and sail, in all major hull materials
- 4. Cuts, trims, waves, and colours hair; massages face and scalp; trims beards and mustaches
- 5. Joins, cuts, or shapes metal using electric arc, oxyacetylene flame, or other processes
- 9. Makes breads, pastries, cookies, and cakes
- 11. Works with wood or wood substitutes in the construction of buildings
- 13. Repairs, installs and adjusts locks, and maintains safes and vaults
- 14. Installs and repairs mechanical locks
- 15. Installs insulating materials in commercial and industrial structures; removes asbestos
- 16. Stores and dispenses automotive, heavy duty, or farm machinery parts

## Down

- 1. Builds, erects, constructs, and joins structural steel used in buildings, bridges, and towers
- 2. Builds, tests, and repairs air-tight and liquid-tight containers such as boilers and storage tanks
- 3. Covers, repairs and decorates surfaces using ceramic, marble and other materials
- 6. Installs and repairs single- or multi-ply roofing systems, shingles, and pre-formed rigid sheeting
- 7. Prepares, installs, and replaces glass
- 8. Builds and repairs walls, floors, fireplaces, walkways with bricks, blocks, and stones
- 10. Operates metal-cutting and shaping machinery
- 11. Prepares food and meals in hotels, restaurants, and institutions
- 12. Installs and repairs piping and other equipment used to move, store, or dispose of water, gas, and sewage
